A Little Latin...A Little History. Highlights of the reign of each king.

The *comitia curiata* was established under King Romulus' rule. The *curiata* politically represented three tribes, Roman, Sabine and Etruscan. It was designed to curb the power of the king through legislation. However, Romulus often circumvented this assembly by interpreting the will of the gods as was his right as king. He also had the *Celeres*, his personal body guards to enforce his will.
