A Little Latin...A Little History. Highlights of the reign of each king.

Numa Pompilius was elected by the Senate as the second King of Rome. Even though the Romans had a monarchy, the title of king was not an inherited position. The Senate took its time in finding a suitable replacement meaning that for a time there was no king. Instead an *interregnum* was chosen by the senators. Each “between king” ruled for several days, then another senator took the very temporary position.
