### ***A Little Latin...A Little History.***

Servius Tullius, the 6<sup>th</sup> king of the Monarchy reigned from 578-534 BC. He developed the first Roman census. Tullius reformed the *comitia curiata* based upon the census becoming the *comitia centuriata*. This assembly now included representation of the poorer classes. His reforms angered the patricians. Some patricians along with his own daughter murdered him driving his body into the ground by a chariot. His daughter further conspired to have her husband, Tarquinius Superbus, become king.
