### ***A Little Latin...A Little History.***

The last Monarch, Tarquinius Superbus (reigned 534-509 BC) was the son of Tarquinius Priscus, the third king. He ruled with terror waging war against all Senate members loyal to his predecessor. His dislike invoked a city-wide rebellion in 509 BC. He was exiled in Etruria since he was of Etruscan roots. The overthrow of Superbus marked the end of the Roman Monarchy and the beginning of the Roman Republic.
