The government of the Republic formed consuls of two Roman citizens who were elected for a one year term. Re-elections were allowed at the beginning but during the second century BC this was changed to one term only. The two consuls ruled together and were allowed to veto each other's decisions. These regulations were designed to balance the power safeguarding against despotism.
