A Little Latin...A Little History

The *comitia centuriata* appointed the two consuls. The *comitia centuriata* meant annually to appoint censors, *praetors, aediles*, and magistrates for the following year. *Aediles* were responsible for the maintenance of public buildings. *Praetors* were commanders of armies and served other magisterial duties. Censors had the responsibilities of maintaining the census, supervising public morality (as if) amongst other duties.
