Appius Claudius was the censor who commissioned the Appian Way (Via Appia). This road originally was built from Rome to Capua. Later it was expanded to Brundisium. Construction began in 312 BC. The Via Appia was the most famous and important Roman road for transportation of goods and peoples. The Appia Way was used by soldiers. The Romans were master road builders and parts of the road still exist today.
