## A Little Latin...A Little History

The Romans even had city managers called *aediles*. Appointed by the *comitia centuriata*, the *aediles* had the responsibilities of running the markets, the public games and the temples. They were in charge of temple and street repairs as well as the aqueducts. They also oversaw the weight and measures at the markets, along with distributing grain. The *aediles* were given judicial powers which allowed them to impose fines. (Think of the control they had over day to day operations of Rome!)
