A Little Latin...A Little History.

The Roman Monarchy (753 -509 B.C.) was reigned by seven kings. The kings were Romulus (753-716 BC), Numa Pompilius (715-674 BC), Tullus Hostilius (673-643 BC), Ancus Maricus (642-618 BC), Lucius Tarquinius Priscus (617-579 BC), Servius Tullius (578-535 BC), and Lucius Tarquinius Superbus (534-510 BC).

N.B. There are date discrepancies between resources re: the reigns of Hostilius and Maricus.
